

## Swim Lesson Provider Network Requirements

The USA Swimming Foundation aims to provide the opportunity for every child in America to learn to swim. The USA Swimming Foundation strongly recommends swim lesson providers who meet or exceed industry best practices. Providers within the USA Swimming Foundation learn-to-swim network

go above and beyond to provide a safe environment and facility by using trained and certified instructors and lifeguards, a low student to teacher ratio, and industry best-practices to empower children with the life-saving skill of learning to swim.

## Organizations wishing to apply for participation in the USA Swimming Foundation's swim lesson provider network must meet the following minimum requirements:

- 1. Curriculum:
  - a. A nationally recognized learn-to-swim curriculum (e.g. Red Cross, YMCA, SwimAmerica, Starfish Swimming, etc.)
     OR
  - Any independently-developed learn-to-swim curriculum reviewed and approved by the USA Swimming Foundation
- Trained instructors and on-deck lifeguards holding current CPR and First Aid certification
- 3. Maximum 6:1 student to instructor ratio
- 4. Each child must receive a minimum of four (4) hours of in-water instruction per session, or be enrolled in a perpetual program with a minimum of one class per week
- 5. Proof of insurance for the program with the following minimum limits:

Each Occurrence: \$1,000,000

General Aggregate: \$3,000,000

- Formal, practiced, Emergency Action Plan for each location or program site
- 8. Operate in a facility regulated by the Department of Health or similar governing agency

In addition to maintaining the requirements above, organizations wishing to apply for participation in the USA Swimming Foundation's swim lesson provider network must be willing to provide the following:

- Annual Enrollment Data: Number of unique children enrolled in the program (Spring, Summer, Fall)—statistics are kept on the following:
  - a. Total number of unique enrolled participants
  - b. Number of participants served with USA Swimming Foundation grant dollars (grant recipients only)
  - c. Number of participants served through local scholarship opportunities (i.e., funded by the program directly)
  - d. Additional information when applicable
- Placement of the USA Swimming Foundation Logo with live link to usaswimmingfoundation.org on the program website, and display official signage and/or branding in all program facilities, as permitted.
- 3. Completed, signed indemnification statement and W9 form.

- Eligibility to apply for grant dollars to support children who otherwise would not participate in learn-to-swim programming
- 5. Free or reduced rates on organizational memberships and educational opportunities, including the Children With Challenges™ online course for programs offering services for children with special needs
- 6. Access to lower rates on general liability insurance
