Treasurer Mr. R. Max Ritter, reported on the state of finances and the probable "cost" and budget for Melbourne.

Chairman Roeser announced the list of events, necessary number of participants for each and the governing conditions for the Olympic Games. Armed Forces participation was discussed. The committee set the date for election of coaches and managers for the December 2, 1955, meeting at Louisville, Ky.

The sixth meeting was held at the swimming stadium, Los Angeles, Calif., July 21, 1955. Mr. Robert Royer replaced Mr. Richard Papenguth on the committee.

Possible sites for the final Olympic Tryouts were offered. It was noted that \$15,000 would be the minimum bid acceptable with August 1956 as the most appropriate time.

The seventh meeting was conducted at the Brown Hotel, Louisville, Ky., December 2, 1955. All members attended (14) except Tom Haynie and Howard Stepp. Mr. John H. Higgins replaced Lt. Com. Ralph Horwitz for the Navy. Major Arthur W. Latta replaced Major Albert Fowler for the Marines. The Men's Final Olympic Trials were awarded to Detroit, Michigan. The accepted bid was \$15,000. The Women's finals were to be conducted at the same time. In addition, 50 per cent of the profit was to be distributed to the Men's committee and a like amount to the Women's committee. All other plans were satisfactory.

It was agreed that in selecting members for the breast stroke and butterfly events that the first place in the final trials in the breaststroke and the first place in the butterfly would be selected by the committee on the relative excellence of the second place "breastroker" versus second place "butterflyer" on a "world wide basis".

Mr. Robert B. Muir, Williamstown, Mass., was elected coach of the team. Mr. Karl B. Michael, Hanover, N. H., was elected diving coach. Mr. Charles O. Roeser, Lansdowne, Pa., was elected manager. Colonel Taylor Drysdale, U.S.A.F. was elected assistant manager. These selections were forwarded to the Executive Committee for approval.

Plans were formulated to insure immediate replacements in case any selected team member could not compete at Melbourne in November for any reason. Competitors who finished "4-5-6" in their respective events at the final trials

were to be listed "auxiliaries". Training plans of the Armed Forces were presented.

The eighth meeting was held at Ray Tomkins House, Yale University, New Haven, Conn., April 6, 1956. The dates of the final Olympic trials at Detroit, Michigan were set for the Brennan Pools, August 7, 8, 9, 10, 1956. The "order of events" as approved by the sub-committee was adopted.

The ninth meeting was held at Detroit, Michigan, August 7, 8, 9, 10, 1956 during the final Olympic tryouts in the Brennan Pools. The splendid equipment, excellent facilities and complete cooperation of the Detroit Olympic Committee could only result in the ideal meet inducing the best efforts from America's outstanding competitors.

At the conclusion of the final event on the evening of August 10th, the U. S. Olympic Men's Swimming Committee approved unanimously the team selections, as decided

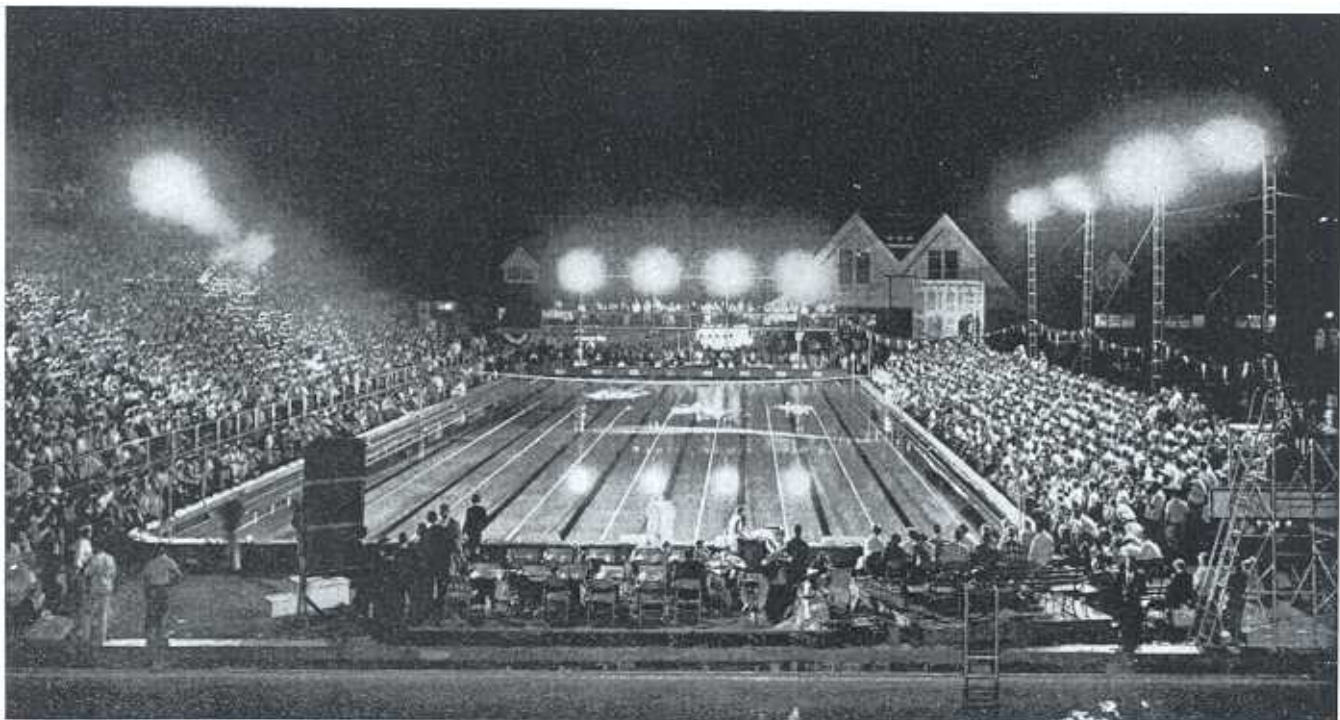

daily sessions of conditioning for both swimmers and divers. On November 9th, the team departed for Australia ready for the vigorous competition ahead.

In the swimming and diving competition, the U. S. A. girls won clean sweeps in the 100 meters butterfly stroke and the platform diving. Incidentally, they were alone in scoring TWO clean sweeps. Our team competition ran to the last day of the Games and the girls were doing their very best to be among the leaders. The girls accomplished their objective by finishing with 19 places in medal and scoring positions—three first-place gold medals, eight second-place silver medals, three third-place bronze medals plus three fourth-places, one fifth and one sixth. Unofficial scoring revealed that our U. S. A. Olympic Women's Swimming and Diving Team more than doubled the points scored by runnerup Australia.

Needless to say, our team was brought to peak form through the diligent efforts of swimming coach Stan Tinkham and diving coach Glenn McCormick.

also expressed to the Detroit Olympic Swimming Committee and chairman Charles H. Mayne whose tireless industry and hearty enthusiasm did so much to insure the success of the entire program.

Sincere thanks is tendered to our two distinguished Detroit benefactors and sportsmen, Mr. Frederick C. Matthaei, chairman Detroit Olympic Committee and Mr. Douglas F. Roby, vice-president, U. S. Olympic Committee.

With the guarantee of \$15,000 for the final tryouts plus an additional \$11,000 from the net profit, the U. S. Olympic Men's Swimming Committee raised more than the quota of funds necessary to meet the expenses of the round trip to Melbourne.

During the short stay in Los Angeles prior to departure, the team was extended many courtesies. To all who provided entertainment, transportation, equipment and assistance the committee expresses its appreciation for this thoughtful consideration.

It is emphasized that 11 of our 16 committee members attended the Olympic Games in Melbourne. All served in some official capacity.

It is recommended that minimum standards of achievement be established to be met by a swimmer to compete in the final Olympic tryouts. Below is the list suggested from the consensus of opinions by interested qualified authorities. It is provided as a "starting point for future deliberation".
