- 1. Call to order 1:02 pm
- 2. Approve Agenda Approved
- 3. Approve Meeting Notes February 11, 2025 Approved
- 4. SWIMS 3.0 Updates/Releases Eric
 - a. Lot of National Team stuff
 - b. Upgrades to Groups
 - c. Looking to see if clubs/members can renew/register early
 - i. Recommends doing it through a third party
 - 1. Third parties have different payment policies which is why it is recommended
 - ii. If they register early, they are not officially a member until 9/1
 - iii. Group to think about this and give feedback
 - iv. Impacts on accounting, transaction reports
 - v. The process needs rules and all LSCs must be on the same page
 - vi. The transaction needs to reflect the correct date
- 5. OMR Process Eric
 - a. OMR releases coming up
 - b. Eric will provide screenshots to the group
 - c. Some changes have already been made
 - i. Select button moved to right
 - d. The process will remain the same
 - e. Easier to add roles without having to go through the club's registration link
 - f. Need to put a policy in place and change the bylaws
 - g. Clubs will have to set their dates for individual season, which they can do more than once
- 6. Seasonal Membership Types Angela/Eric
 - a. Committee needs to decide how seasonal will work going forward
 - b. It is recommended that the Individual Season is offered
- 7. LSC Non-athlete Fees Eric
 - a. Has the committee had an feedback on having LSCs only have one fee for all non-athlete membership types except for Administrator
 - b. Must have something by May 15 if something is going to be proposed
 - c. LSC charge differently for the different types based on how the LSC manage this
 - d. Susan will go through the list and sort it and get help from the committee to discuss with each LSC
 - i. Administrator who is eligible for this

- 1. Eric discussed this category with Michele and Derek
- 2. Anyone in the past who had to register as Other, should remain as Other
- 3. There is no differential in bylaws or rulebook that addresses this
- 4. Administrators should only be for club board members, and everyone else register as Other
- Anyone with Admin access to SWIMS should be registered as Other, excluding Club admins
- 6. Will need the committee's buy in to move this forward
- 7. Can we delete Administrator LSC Club Development and LSC Development will need to be included in the discussion
- 8. This is impossible to validate, this is a club issue
- 9. This isn't only based on Safe Sport, where something else can be done without club boards registering as Administrators
- 10. What are the differences on how a board relates to the different club owned typed
- 11. If Administrator is removed, it may be looked at a money grab from USAS
- 12. Can we change the name, and it will be clear as to who this applies to
- 13. It's hard to determine the club board members of club, and their role
- 8. Registration / Membership Manual update
 - a. Nothing new to report currently
 - b. Start with an outline based on the old manual and start adding information that addresses each topic
 - c. Eric will send the editable version to committee to get started
- 9. Best Practices at the LSC level Angela, Susan, Tracy, and Moriah
 - a. Angela sent a draft document to get started
 - b. The group will review, discuss and update
 - c. Looking to have a draft to review for the Reg / Mem early April
 - d. Once review and finalized will make available to all LSCs
- 10. New Club Process Karin
 - a. Revamped part of the new club application
 - b. The process is being slowed down to have time to review critical documents/resumes
 - c. Provide a timeline to help manage expectations
 - d. Provide specific information based on club owned entity
 - e. Provide training to LSCs on how the new club process works
 - f. Provide steps, flowcharts to give new clubs clarity and the requirements to be completed to speed up the process
 - g. Have the Reg/Mem committee review some information to help streamline the process
 - h. Look at the HC requirement and revise it requirements to fit when trying to start a new club
- 11. Outreach families affected by the Federal Employee firings/layoffs Susan
 - a. Are there other LSCs affected and how are they managing this
 - b. Maryland will provide relief with discounted entry fees and other benefits
 - c. Going forward, this will most likely increase
 - d. Possibly look at other financial assistance and clubs are also providing assistance
- 12. LSC Outreach Marketing/Policy Tracy and Susan



- a. Tracy and Susan have a draft and will be finalizing it to get out to the LSCs
