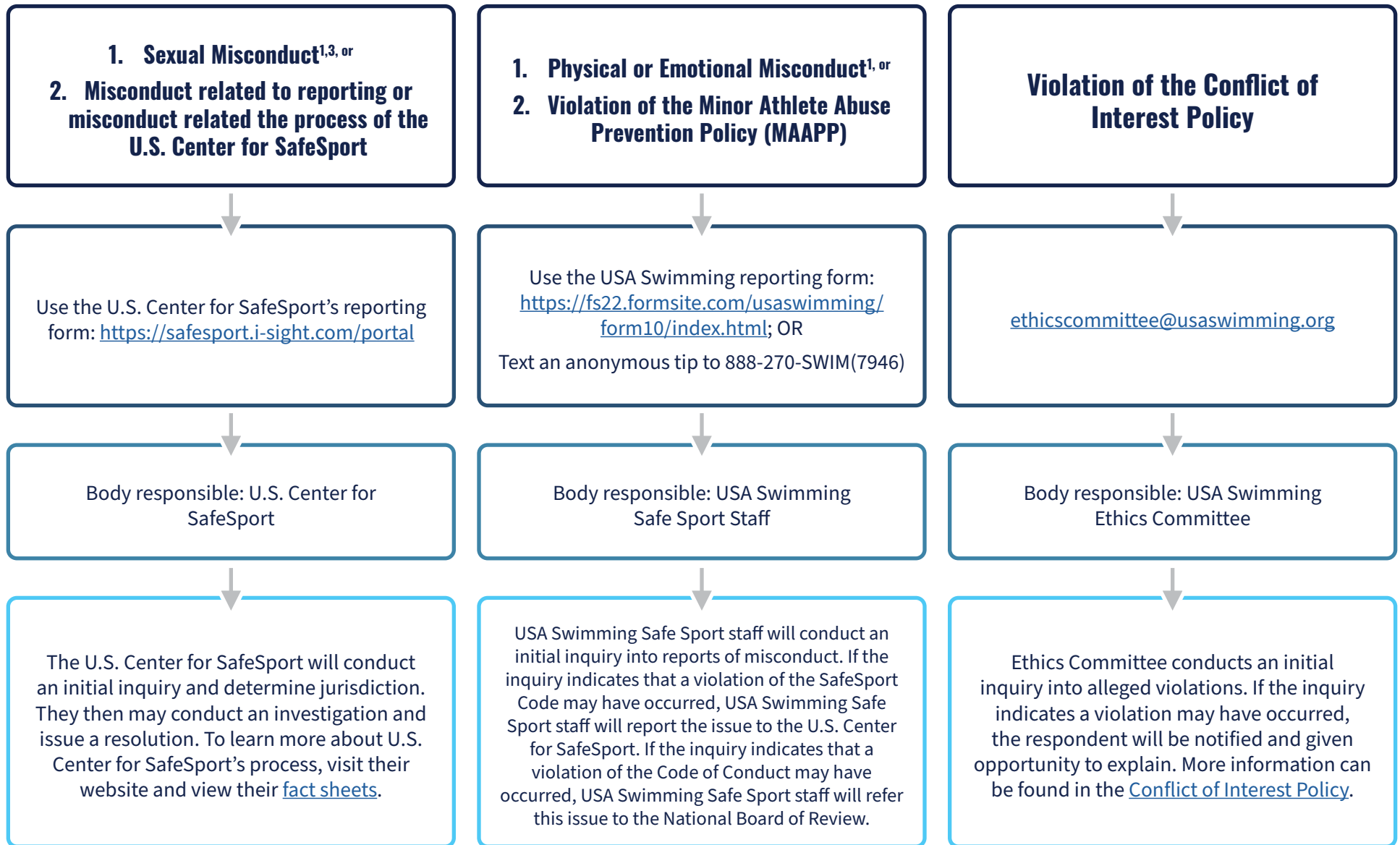


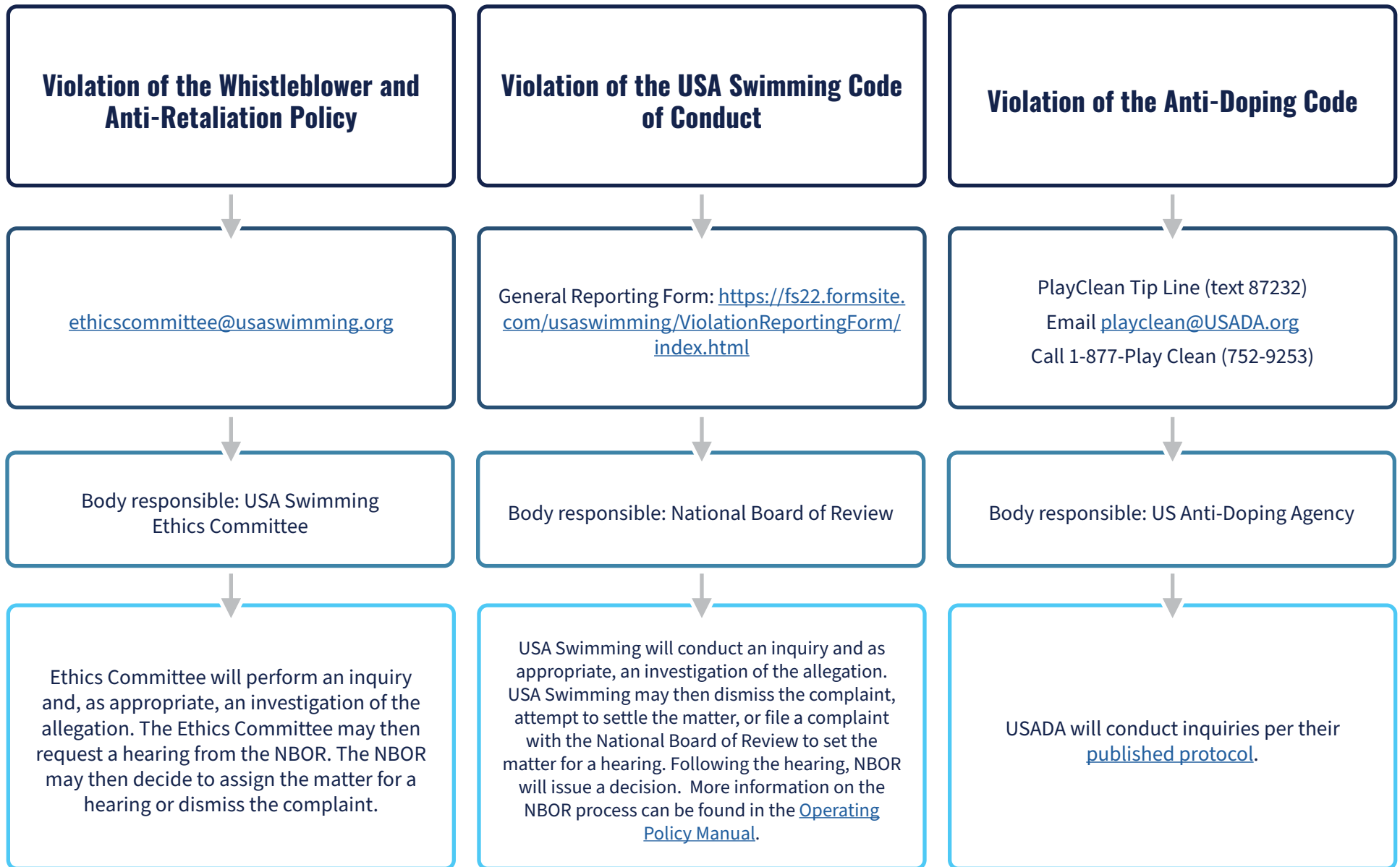

REPORTING PATHWAYS

Any issues reported to USA Swimming through any channel will undergo an initial inquiry to determine whether USA Swimming has jurisdiction and whether the complaint alleges an actual violation of our rules and/or policies.

If the issue is determined to meet these two thresholds but was not reported through the appropriate pathway, the investigating body will refer the complainant to the appropriate channel.

If the issue is determined to not meet these two thresholds, but another pathway to resolution is identified, the complaining party may be referred to: Team Services, the LSC, the club, local law enforcement, or other entities.

1. The [SafeSport Code](#) defines the terms Sexual Misconduct, Emotional Misconduct, and Physical Misconduct.
2. The U.S. Center for SafeSport is a separate organization with its own employees that has jurisdiction over USA Swimming.
3. Any Adult Participant who learns of information or reasonably suspects that a child has suffered an incident of Child Abuse, including sexual abuse, must immediately make a report to law enforcement, make a report to the U.S. Center for SafeSport, and comply with any other applicable reporting requirements under state law.
