- The webpage should be accessible by everyone and should not require a login.
- Step 2. Include your club Safe Sport Coordinator name and contact details.
- Step 3. Include USA Swimming reporting and contact information.
- Step 4. Include U.S. Center for SafeSport reporting and contact information.
